Dear parents,

as you have certainly already heard from the press, the 1st and 5th classes will be offered face-to-face lessons again from 11.5.

It is the responsibility of the school to implement this complex task taking into account the hygiene requirements, the premises of the school and the available staff.

We have known since yesterday evening that the 1st classes are now also to be considered for attendance lessons.

We can only meet the hygienic requirements if we reduce the number of lessons offered to the classes, work in a shift model and divide small learning groups. In addition, the presence lessons are combined with learning offers for at home.

From 25.5. onwards, we are planning to reduce the number of face-to-face lessons for all grades. This will only be possible on a daily basis and in a shift model, as we have to comply with the requirements of the hygiene plan and only have limited pedagogical staff available.

You will receive our detailed planning in due course.

- IMPORTANT for all parents:

Recently, we have observed that more and more parents and children have met on the school grounds when picking up learning materials. It is understandable that the children are happy to see their classmates again. However, we as a school have to make sure that the hygiene plan of the Senate School Administration is observed.

Therefore, when staying in the building and on the courtyard in front of the entrances, the following applies

1. please stay in the building as briefly as possible.
2. please wear a mouth guard.
3. please observe the necessary distance rules of 1.5 metres.
4. please also pay attention to the children you bring with you. They should also wear a face masks and observe the rules of distance.

- The number of children in emergency care is increasing. If you are entitled to place your child in emergency care, please continue to let us know as early as possible if and when your child is attending.
